## Items of Interest from Fr. Gifford:

- Fall Activity Fair
  - Have one to group in with recruiting moment
  - Held stewardship fair about 9 years ago groups would highlight what they do
    - There was hurt feelings and dissatisfaction in the past with people involved
    - Parishioners need to engage many at Sunday mass that are not connected
      - This will give opportunity but need to keep up after event
        - Discussions with groups tied to the event
  - After all masses during a specific time in fall before CCD, bible studies etc begin to get people involved
  - Groups be engaged with parishioners, not just information handed out
    - Give aways, activities challenge booths to be fun and engaging
    - Check in stations with a map of the booths and info
  - Thinking late August summer fest scheduled for August 13th and can unveil this event school starts August 15
    - Tentative weekend of the 27th
    - Julie to get with Kate on notes from past events put together a committee from Parish council to start organizing
- African Missionary Priest parish involvement
  - Two weeks at our parish in summer and will have appeal during second week for their mission
    - He is a missionary to us the church is thriving in Africa and we need Jesus.
    - Father Gifford leaves on July 4<sup>th</sup> and around July 6<sup>th</sup> he will arrive
  - How to work out hospitality?
    - Every other day parishioners provide meals and meet with priest
    - He will not have access to vehicles set up on call drivers if needed for emergency – act of charity to offer up by parishioners
    - Utilize bulletin to set up sign up sheets for the services
    - Theresa will reach out to welcoming committee to get going on it
    - Have two people on point to manage the signup sheet
  - Mother's day will include May crowning at mass
- Following weekend will be graduation mass
  - Tradition in past before covid but people who organized it stepped down
    - New youth leader figuring it out
- Corpus Christi are the two Sundays after Pentecost

- Revival of Eucharist procession with afternoon adoration
- Have a simple approach
  - One of the masses have a simple procession with the Eucharist going outside walking down Ogden for the group of parishioners to follow Jesus
- Children mass to look at availability by volunteers to schedule in June, maybe July
- Totus Tuus on radar

    - Wish list from David Wallack to Father included:
      - IPAD for streaming (possible donation), laptop for library, network access points (going through Twin Cities IT) as church office too old, network cable upgrade, outdoor marque to be used with school (getting donors about \$15,000), information board in narthex (possible TV that was used during covid), Screens in church – controversial
      - Do we need a committee for technology currently just David with small team that worked on live streaming but moving away from this and utilizing Twin Cities

    - March was a big step for her and would like to add members
    - Get with Henry County Rights for Life
    - Did not connect with Altar and Rosary

      - Include this possibly as ministry at the activities fair
      - Get more commissioning
    - Knights of Columbus supports other service groups in need of recruites
      - Getting the youth involved
  - Darci successful retreats planned in spring
    - Kimberly planning Totus Tuus in summer
    - 5-6 teens each week coming from the high school
    - Working on scholarship
    - Not spoken with CCD leaders
