 - No, change in staffing was based on Lance's limited availability.
 - Questions surrounding the elimination of the Parish Nurse position:
 - Father Gifford:
 - Decision based on budgetary considerations and true needs of the parish
 - Wellness committee will consider needs of the parish (2 priests and pastoral care team already minister to those who are ill)
 - o Question of appreciation/send off for Cathie Stinson
 - Father Gifford: While she was a gift to our parish and will be greatly missed. Discussed recognition and will be followed up by Kathy Hanford.
